Cornerstone Ranch, 2722 Bailey Road, Leeds, Alabama 35094

***Going East on I 20 from Atlanta** (It's 131 miles from Atlanta) Get off on Exit 140/Hiway 78 - at end of ramp turn left, go .9 mi. See Rex Lake Rd and turn right. Go 1 mile and turn left on Ziegler Rd. (there is construction-if no sign-just know it is your first paved road on your left. Go 2 miles to dead end and turn right on Highway 119. Go 1.9 miles and turn right on Bailey Rd. Go to 3rd driveway on right (turn in here) and follow past red house and red barn to end of drive to main barns.

***Going east on Hiway 280** toward Birmingham turn right on Hiway 119 and go 6.7 miles to Bailey Rd on left and turn. Go to 3rd driveway on right and turn in go past red house and barn and follow drive to main barns.

***From I-65** take exit 246 Cahaba Valley Road. Head North on Hiway 119. Approximately 9 miles to intersection of U.S. Highway 280. Cross 280 and continue on Hiway 119. From this intersection go 6.7 miles to Bailey Rd on left and turn. Go to 3rd driveway on right and turn in go past red house and barn and follow drive to main barns.

ALL EXHIBITORS:

*Must have current Negative Coggins report to be shown before unloading horse at farm

*Clinic Exhibitor entry form completed and turned in

*Clinic Exhibitor payment (if you did not prepay). All checks made out to AAHA

*Liability release form signed. All youth must have liability release signed by parent or legal guardian—no exceptions.

*No camping or staying in horse trailers during the weekend/clinic

*All exhibitors will be expected to bring their own feed, hay, tack, supplies and all necessary horse equipment.

*Initial bedding furnished in each horse stall. Additional shavings may be purchased from Cornerstone Ranch or you may bring your own.

*All exhibitors will be expected to clean/muck their own stall during the clinic.

*Clinic Exhibitors may arrive after 3 P.M., September 3rd

*Auditors welcome on Saturday and Sunday September 4th and 5th

*Exhibitors clinic fee will include: stall bedded with initial shavings for the weekend, clinic

Lunging equipment—long lines, lunge line, lunge whip

Saddle and Pad

Work Bridle and work reins—regular reins and draw reins (Show Bridle optional, but must bring work tack)

Snaffle Bit (several if possible)

Running Martingale or training fork

Caveson

Box Fan for your horses stall—depending on weather at time of clinic

Riding bat/crop

Helmet (mandatory for junior riders) Adults Optional

Appropriate boots for riding

Brushes, sweat scrape, fly spray and any other grooming supplies
